Guidelines for Wood Auction Sellers and Buyers

Information for Sellers:

- Only wood and forestry-related products will be considered.
- In the interest of wood auction sellers, the number of lots is limited to 100.
- Lumber lot sizes less than 100 FBM are preferred. (1 FBM is equivalent to: 12" in length x 12" in width" x 1" in depth)
- The preferred species include: black cherry, butternut, sugar maple, oak, white pine, yellow and white birch, walnut and specialty wood such as spalted and birds-eye maple and wormy butternut.
- Burls should preferably be 12" in diameter or more.
- All products should be clean.
- Information on wood dryness will need to be provided (i.e. kiln or air dried and length of time).
- For information on most saleable species and prices paid in previous years (Glengarry Wood Fair, in Dunvegan), please consult our website (www.boisesest.ca/Wood&Forest).
- Wood auction deliveries will be accepted between 9:00 am and 1:00 pm on Saturday, 9 September. No wood will be accepted on Sunday, 10 September.
- The auction fee will be set at 10% of selling price.
- All lumber will be scaled upon delivery, with an agreed volume estimate between the scaler and the seller. The products for sale will be placed on rails under a barn for presentation.
- The auction will begin at 3:00 pm.
- Neither Boisés Est nor the Riceville Agricultural Society, owner of the exhibition grounds, will accept any liability for lost, damaged or stolen wood auction products.
- Any unsold wood must be picked up before 7 pm on Sunday, 10 September 2017.
- By signing the attached registration form, Wood Auction Sellers agree to all conditions described above.

Information for Buyers:

- A list of all products offered for sale may be purchased for \$2.00 on Sunday, 10 September.
- Payment for purchases must be made by the end of the auction on Sunday, 10 September.
- Make cheques payable to **Boisés Est enr.** **Please note that payment can only be made by cheque or cash.** The nearest ATM facility will be a few minutes away, in Saint-Isidore.
- Pickup of products may begin when payment has been made. For reasons of safety and liability, removal of purchased products can only be done by hand until the end of the auction. Buyers will have to adhere strictly to instructions provided.
- Buyers must collect purchased products before 7 pm on Sunday, 10 September 2017.
